Subsequent to graduating from the University of Alberta with a B.Sc. in Civil Engineering in 1971, Jim has been involved in the land development industry.

For a little more than two years subsequent to graduation, he worked for the City of Edmonton in the Subdivision Development and Realty Development Office, the predecessor to Development Coordination.

Subsequent to working with the City of Edmonton, Jim worked in the consulting field providing consulting services to the land development industry. Initially, he worked with Strong Lamb and Nelson, a consulting firm that was subsequently acquired by Stanley Associates (Stantec). Following SLN he joined Bruyer Halahuric & Associates which evolved into Bruyer Partnership, Bruyer Consulting and Brycon Consulting Group, which was then acquired by Stanley in 1986. Subsequent to the acquisition of Brycon Consulting Group by Stanley, he consulted to the Stanley organization for two years under the IMC Consulting Group banner.

After leaving the consulting industry, he worked as a developer, firstly, with the Lehndorff Group, and continuing on with Sherrick Management Limited.
