

LARRY SEMENIUK
P.Eng., B.Sc. (Engineering)

Larry was born in Edmonton but raised on a farm north of the city until his early teens. After graduating from high school he attended the Northern Alberta Institute of Technology (NAIT), receiving a diploma in Architectural Technology (1973), and the University of Alberta receiving a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering (1979).

Larry is presently the Vice President of IGL Canada Ltd., a sewer, water and heavy civil site development contracting company that also specializes in municipal infrastructure renewal. IGL was just recently purchased by the Sureway group of companies.

However, a large portion of Larry's career (25 years) was spent within the consulting engineering industry (including 3 years in his own practice). The majority of his consulting practice related to land development and municipal infrastructure. Also, although most of his engineering career was conducted in the Edmonton area, he spent 2 years in Phoenix, Arizona (1995-1997) with Stantec (currently he is registered in both Alberta and Arizona as a Professional Engineer). During his time in Arizona, Larry worked with most of the municipalities in the Phoenix area, including Sedona, a small resort city in the northern part of the state.

This varied experience has provided Larry with extensive exposure to various engineering standards, infrastructure design and construction. His expertise has been utilized extensively while participating on a multitude of committees with both UDI and ARHCA that relate to design and construction standards.

Other volunteer experience includes being a director of the Alberta Roadbuilders and Heavy Construction Association, a member of the UDI

standards review committees (involving drainage, waterworks and transportation); acting as president of the Edmonton-Leduc Conservative Association Board of Directors, and being chairman of First Millwoods United Church. Presently he is serving as the president of the Edmonton Country Club.
